



COVID -19 Safety Protocols

Safely conducting driver training is essential...

Instructors and students agree to abide by the following **Safety Protocols** during all training sessions until further notice;

Prior to each lesson, a student will be asked a set of screening questions to assess their health and exposure risks.

Prior to each lesson, the interior of the training car (and the exterior door handle) will be wiped down with a disinfecting product. All components that a student could potentially come in contact with will be sanitized to the best of our ability.

The instructor will apply hand sanitizer before each lesson.

The instructor will provide hand sanitizer to each student to apply prior to entering the car.

Each person in the training vehicle is required to wear a protective face mask*. If you do not have a mask**, a disposable medical mask will be supplied to you at a \$2.50 surcharge to the lesson rate.

Any paper documents that must be left with the student will be either pre-packaged in advance of the lesson and/or handled with gloves, or emailed to the student.

*Acceptable masks include but are not limited to; a 3-ply cloth mask (reusable/home-made), disposable medical (surgical) mask, disposable non-medical mask.

**There is ongoing and evolving debate on the effectiveness and need for members of the public to wear face masks for day to day activities. There is compelling evidence that the proper use of masks can be an effective tool to reduce the spread of the virus in situations where social distancing is not possible. There are some feel that if you are not sick, around sick people, or are not in a health care environment, that there is no need to wear a mask. We feel at this time, however, that in the consideration of the safety of those around us, and the close proximity within the vehicle, that this precaution outweighs the small temporary inconvenience. Safety for all must be a priority.
